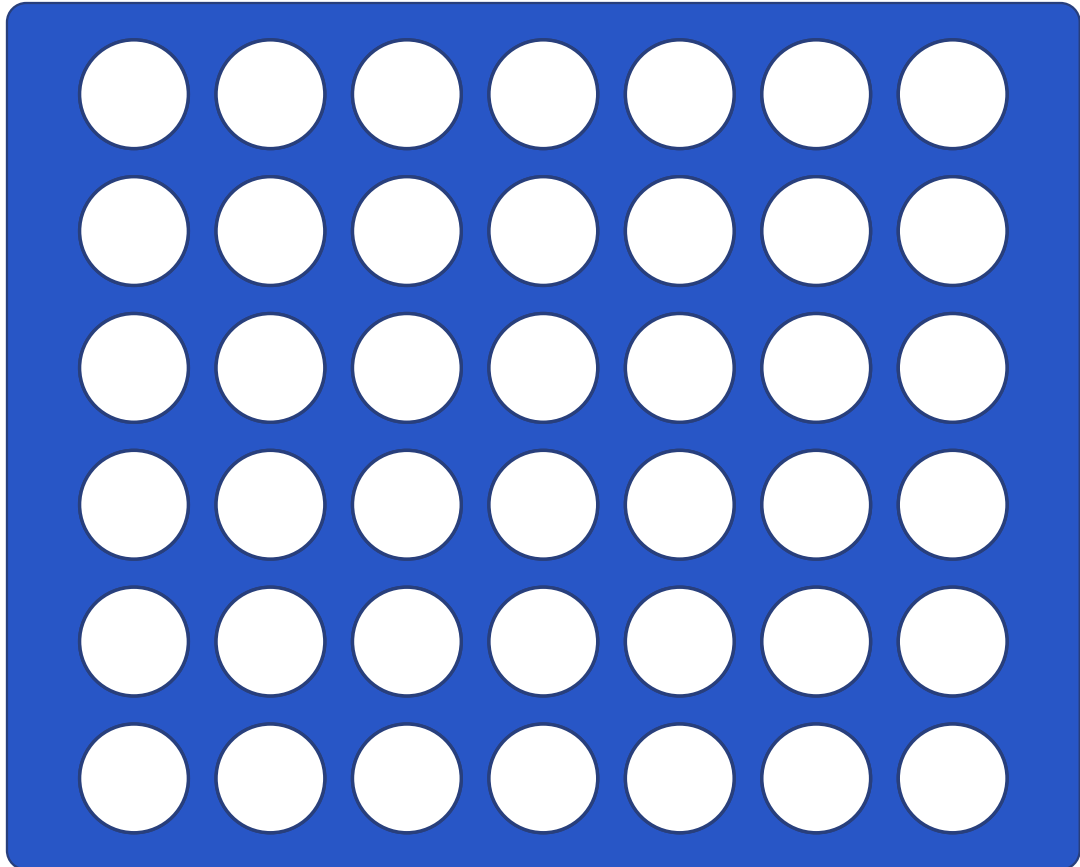


Connect four
